Using the **Johnson Method** to confront the addict by motivating and encouraging them to change their lifestyle for the good of not only themselves, but for the good of the family around them. Also, utilizing the **Arise Intervention Model** (Invitational Approach) A Relational Intervention Sequence of Engagement (ARISE) Model was designed by Dr. Judith Landau and James Garrett along with other clinicians. Unlike the Johnson model, the Arise intervention model involves the addict from the beginning.

Patricia holds Masters level certifications in Addiction Studies with an LAADC and CADC II - in the state of California, as well as an I.C.A.D.C International Certification, and is a Board Registered Interventionist - BRI I, both in the United States and Canada.
